Brown House Museum

Once used as Sherman's headquarters on his March to the Sea the house is a stop on the Georgia Civil War Heritage Trail. Currently the headquarters of the Washington County Historical Society, visitors can view local historical artifacts and a growing pottery collection. The collections also include The Civil War in Washington County Exhibit which is a unique art exhibit detailing events and places in Washington County during the Civil War.

Old City Cemetery

The Victorian Era cemetery is the final resting place of missionaries, a Georgia Governor, Civil War Soldiers, business and county leaders, and prohibitionists. Explore this quiet place to see examples of funerary art of the mid-nineteenth century to art deco monuments of the twentieth century. On the National Register of Historic Places and a stop on the Georgia Civil War Heritage Trails.

The Old Jail Museum and Genealogy Center

Designed as a Victorian home from the front, this 1891 jail is one of two facilities of this type known to exist in the state of Georgia. Also home to the Historical Socieity's geneaology research center, a full staff of volunteers are available to help you research family history, delve deeper into the local history and potentially have the pleasure of meeting the jail's resident ghost, Essie.

Linton Park

At Sandersville's newest and largest park, you can enjoy the North Avenue Station Splash Pad during the spring and summer and the professionally designed and PDGA sanctioned Depot Disc Golf Course year round. Also located in the park is Sandersville School, a Works Progress Administration project from 1939 on land that was part of Ferncrest Plantation. The annual Kaolin Festival is held here the second weekend in October. The park can be accessed from North Harris Street, North Avenue, Sparta Road, and Linton Road in Sandersville.

Warthen Old Jail

Built in 1786, the single cell jail is considered the oldest log jail remaining in the state of Georgia. The jail once held Aaron Burr who was on his way to being tried on a charge of treason before the United States Circuit Court at Richmond, Virginia. On the National Register of Historic Places.

THOMAS JEFFERSON ELDER COMMUNITY CENTER

Built circa 1890 on the original site of the Elder School where education for the African-American children of Washington County had its first founding. Overseen by the Elderite Association, the center houses African-American artifacts, archives memorabilia, auditorium, and meeting rooms. On the National Register of Historic Places.

HAMBURG STATE PARK


A campground offers shaded sites along the edge of quiet Hamburg Lake fed by the Little Ogeechee River. The campground provides hot showers, water and electric hookups, and a dump station. Anglers can enjoy fishing for largemouth bass, crappie and bream, as well as boat ramps and a fishing pier. Wildlife enthusiasts should look for the numerous animals that live within the park. The restored 1921 water-powered gristmill is still operational and used to grind corn during events. The park's museum is also open during events, displaying old agricultural tools and implements used in rural Georgia.


